Yes — under 50.

Colorectal cancer is one of the most preventable cancers when detected early.

### EARLY DETECTION CAN CHANGE THE STORY

In Puerto Rico, screening is recommended beginning at age 40.

There are simple, non-invasive tests that can detect early warning signs before symptoms appear:

- Fecal Immunochemical blood testing (done annually)
- Fecal DNA testing (done every 3 years)
- Colonoscopy (every 5 to 10 years, depending on family history of cancer or colon polyps)

These tests can identify microscopic blood or molecular changes that may signal early-stage cancer or precancerous lesions.
